A NOTE TO LEADERS

WELCOME / PRAYER

Welcome to CommUNITY Group! Take a few minutes to catch up on how this past week has gone for everybody. Then ask if anyone would be willing to pray for God to move during your discussion and to open your hearts and minds to the truth of His Word. If no one is comfortable, its all yours leader!

DISCUSS

- 1) In Aaron's message, he talked a lot about personal faith vs. private faith. What do you see as the main differences between the two?
- 2) Read Matthew 28:18-20. This passage reflects the truth that we're not just called to *BE* disciples of Jesus but we're called to *MAKE* disciples of Jesus. Which is easier? Which reflects your faith?
- 3) Read Matthew 4:18-22. What are some natural responses the first disciples could have had in reply to Jesus that were different than how Scripture says they responded.
- 4) What would you identify as some of your "nets"—those things that you know you must let go of in order to follow Jesus?
- 5) How can the members of this group pray for and support you as you seek to follow Jesus more faithfully?
